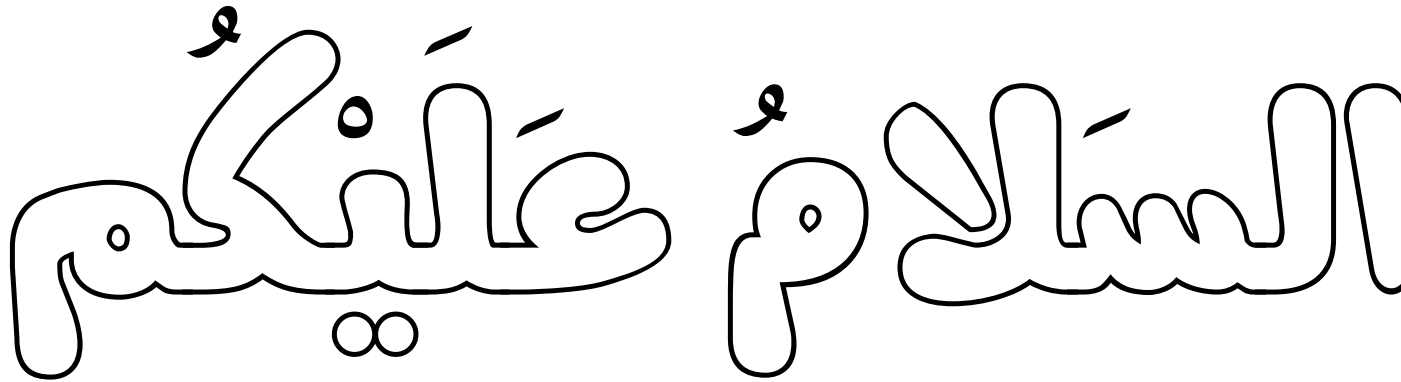

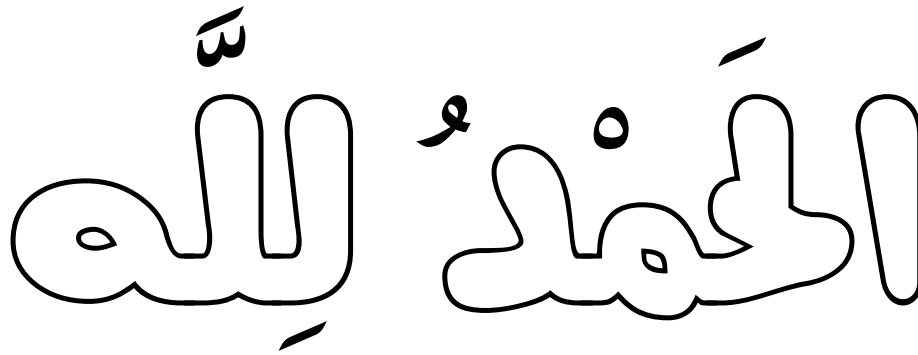

To thank Allāh, when we finish our food and when we sneeze, we say:



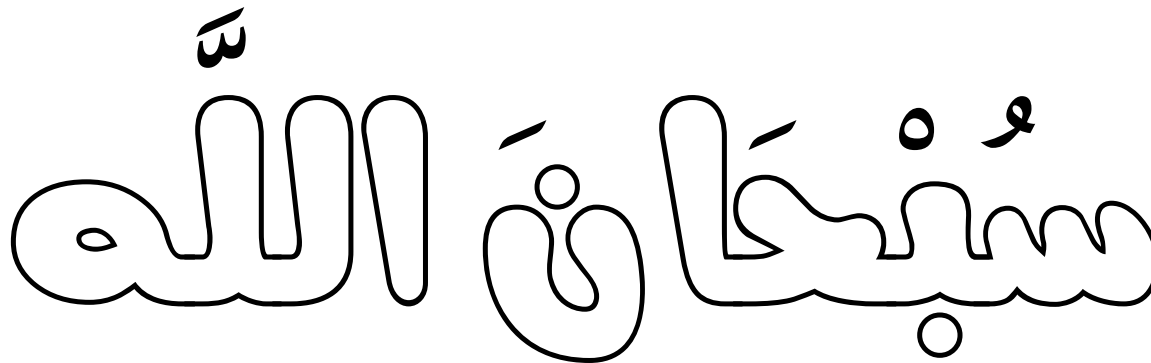
Al-Hamdu lilāh

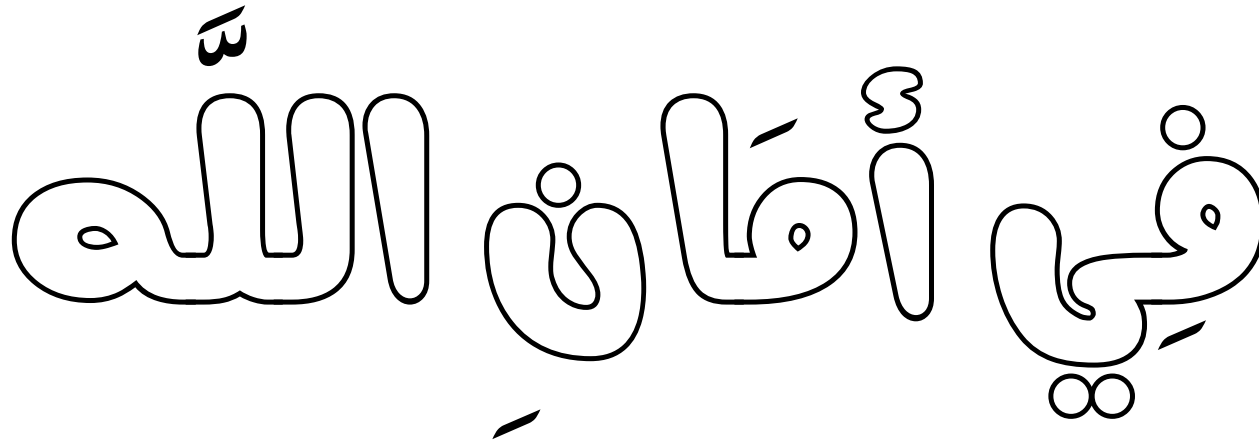
