

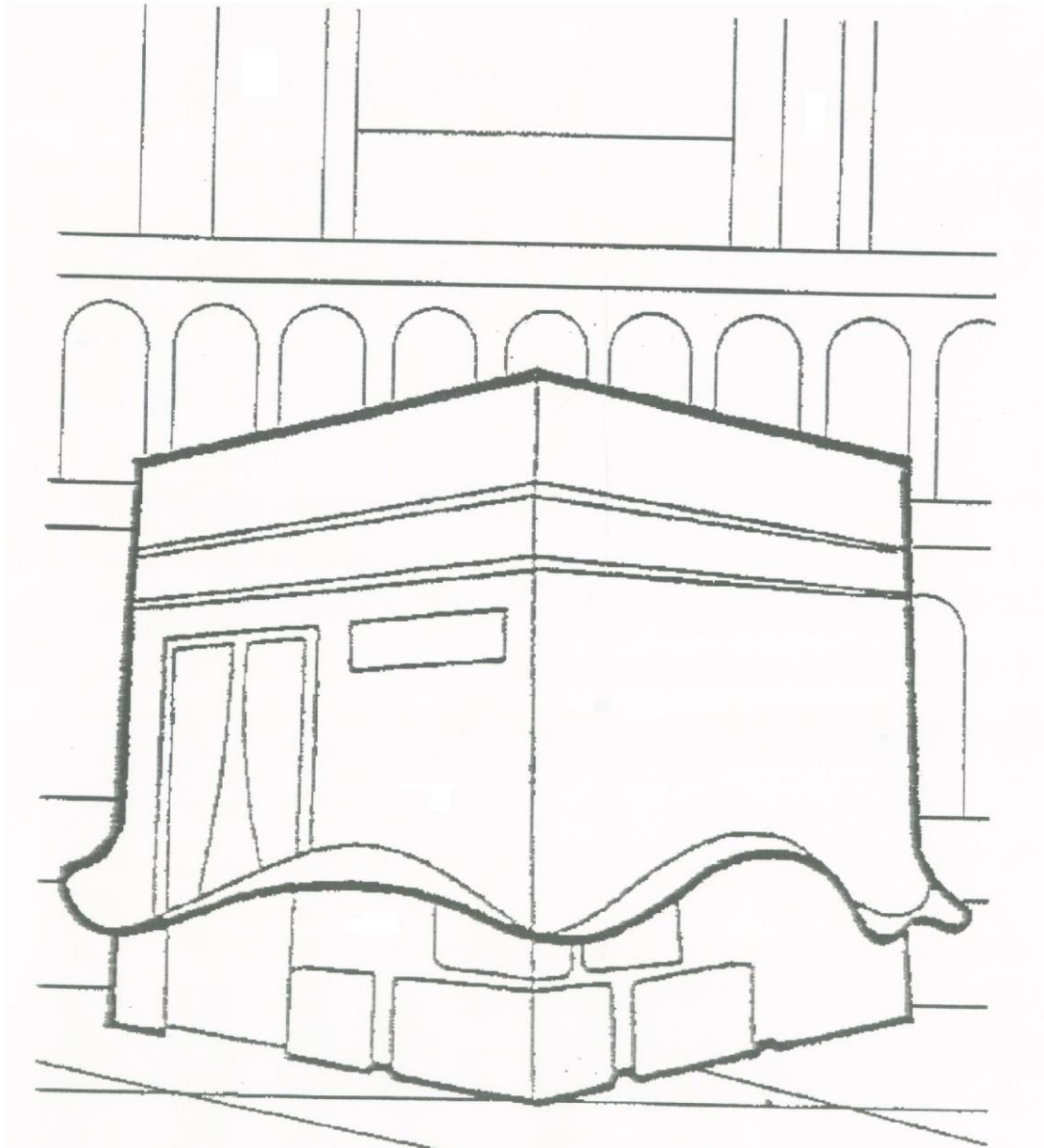

KABAH IS MY QIBLA

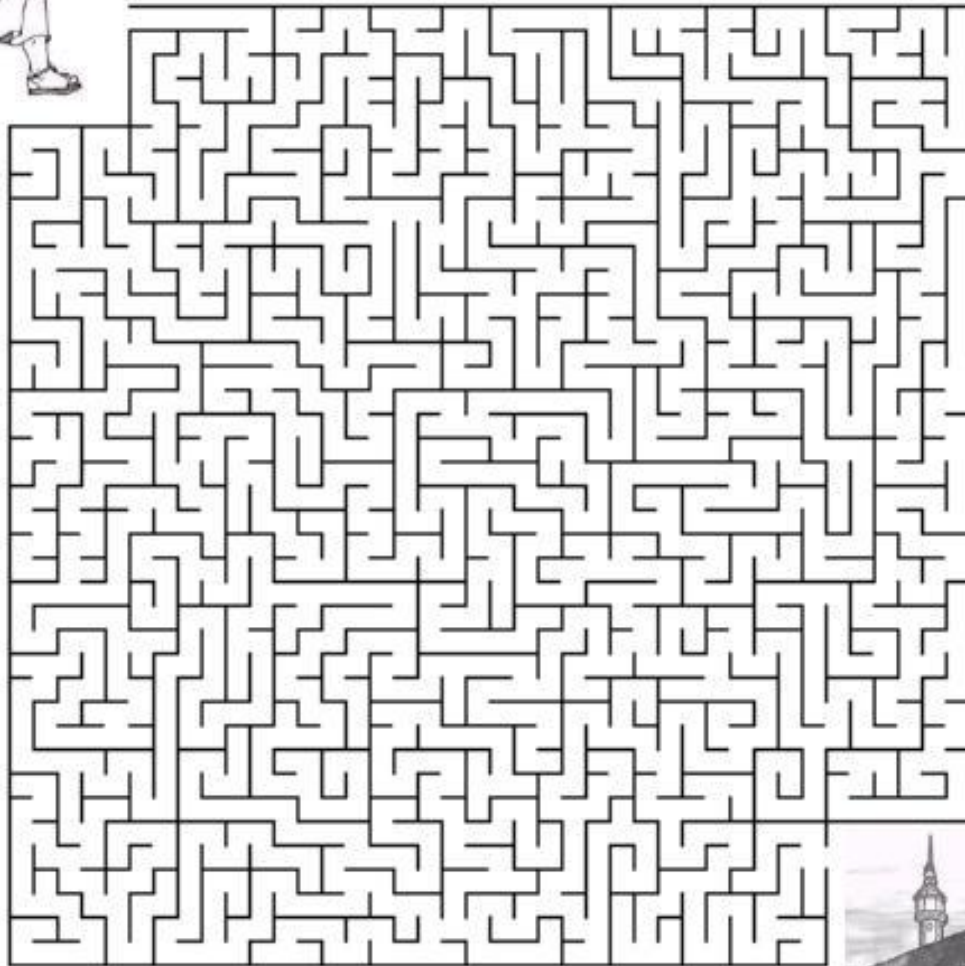
